I would like to convey the profound concern and strong protest of the Government and the People of the Islamic Republic of Iran regarding the illegal and unjustifiable aggressions committed by the United States of America and the Israeli Regime against the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran, and destruction of residential and public areas, including schools, healthcare facilities, emergency centers and sports complexes as well as industrial towns and manufactures, has resulted in the martyrdom of a large number of innocent civilians, particularly elementary school students, university professors and students, patients hospitalized in medical centers, relief workers, industrial workers and labors, and several adolescent athlete. Due to the continuation of these crimes, the number of victims continues to rise. These deliberate acts of aggression constitute a violation of the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international peace and security, the tenets of international law, international humanitarian law, and international human rights law, as well as a breach of the territorial integrity,

independence, and sovereignty of the Islamic Republic of Iran. In addition to causing extensive damage to civilian infrastructure, these attacks have had profound humanitarian consequences and repercussions, including the displacement of residents from areas affected by these assaults.

In the course of the recent aggressions, in addition to the aforementioned actions, the perpetration of terrorist acts against high ranking official figures, notably the supreme leader of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the diplomatic police, the IRIS Dena vessel in the Pacific Ocean, Mehrabad International Airport and fuel depots - which have led to the martyrdom of civilian compatriots and the destruction of infrastructure - represent stark manifestations of explicit violations of international and humanitarian law.

These acts demand a serious response and the special attention of the international community. Accordingly, the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) is expected to strongly condemn these aggressions, these heinous and inhuman crimes, and these repeated violations. The Organization is firmly requested to undertake any actions towards condemning these brutal attacks, including the issuance of statements, convening of meetings, adoption of positions, or any other measures.
